Please refer to each school admissions policy for the oversubscription criteria. In all instances the first two criteria will include:

- 1) Looked after children and children who were looked after but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a residence order or special guardianship order)
- 2) Children who appear to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.

Applications for vacancies that arise outside the normal annual admission round for Reception and Year 7 in any year group will be considered at any time during the year. Information can be obtained directly from each school.
